Specific attention will be paid to the avoidance of contamination of watercourses or groundwater by oil, silt, or chemicals, used in the construction process on site.
- Use materials and products from sustainable sources and products that are re-usable or recyclable. We will encourage our clients to vary their specification in order to achieve this.
- Ensure that our site waste is segregated on site for recycling or possible reuse and that the use, treatment and disposal of any hazardous materials is strictly controlled to eliminate or minimize environmental problems.
- Make every effort to conserve the use of all natural resources, including energy, water and raw materials. We are committed to the reduction of waste in all of our activities and will progressively raise initiatives to achieve this at our offices, depots and sites.
- Develop and encourage the environmental training of management and operatives at all levels. The company will also seek the co-operation of all Sub-contractors and self-employed persons employed on its sites.

Wayne Sampson will also monitor the implementation of this policy and ensure that it is regularly updated.
